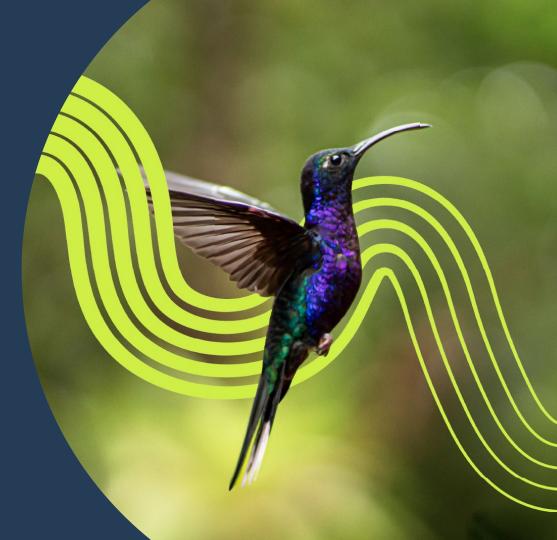




The Science Based Targets Network (SBTN) invites companies to *Step Up* for Nature – a global effort for companies to collectively signal their ambition on credible nature action through science-based targets.

The initiative will highlight private-sector progress toward the 2026 Global Biodiversity Stocktake and demonstrate how companies are helping deliver measurable outcomes for nature.
